Based in a light filled, modern facility next to the Joondalup Health Campus, Ngala Early Learning and Development Service Joondalup aims to meet the needs of the general community as well as Health Campus staff.

Complimentary to our spacious indoor areas, ELDS Joondalup boasts expansive outdoor areas, providing children with enviable play opportunities.

At Ngala Joondalup we believe it is important to get to know each child, by learning their strengths, how they learn and what interests them. This takes time and requires thoughtful, considerate and skilled educators. Our educators form strong attachments with each child and build on their learning over time. They use each child's ideas to plan a meaningful play based environment where children can practice, develop and learn lifelong skills. We provide a strong, positive foundation for the schooling years ahead.



OUR CURRICULUMS

An everyday curriculum is planned for both our indoor and outdoor environments. We believe both areas are equally important and require thoughtfully planned experiences. Our everyday curriculums cover areas such as physically active play, dramatic play, construction and loose parts play.

These experiences are offered over the fortnight, as we believe children need time to practice skills, and then areas are updated/extended or changed into new spaces, based on the children's responses.

NATURAL ENVIRONMENT



We believe that nature play is vital for children's healthy development.

At Ngala Early Learning Centres, children are immersed in nature through both indoor and outdoor activities, and outdoor play is offered all day, at any time (*with the exception of sleep/rest times*).





LEARNING THROUGH PLAY



At Ngala Early Learning and Development Service we support child led play.

Each child can move freely between the indoor and outdoor play spaces, make decisions about where to play, who they will play with and how long they will spend at a particular activity, while Educators provide teaching, support and guidance when children need help.

FROM THE KITCHEN



We prepare your child's food fresh on site every day, using seasonal produce.

Children will be provided with a nutritious morning and afternoon snack and a cooked midday meal and we will happily prepare alternative meals for children with allergies or special dietary requirements.
